PERSONALITY DIMENSIONS®

Personality Dimensions®(PD) is an easily understood method for building self-awareness, self-esteem and effective communication strategies. It uses the self-discovery method to select the temperament that is most like you, and helps to determine your preferred work style, work environment, strengths, challenges, and career fit.

This workshop focuses on exploring your work preferences.

Unlike many career assessment instruments, Career Dimensions[™] helps you to explore the actual work environment in which you are most comfortable by examining a variety of areas, including the natural talents you bring to work, your values, your major job stressors, your work philosophy and your definition of success.

RESUME AND JOB SEARCH WORKSHOP

Resume and Job Search Workshop aims to train students to:

- Acquire techniques to create an effective and structured resume;
- Customise resumes for specific jobs;
- Create presentable cover letter(s); and
- Practice various job search techniques

Students are required to complete their resumes and submit them for Career Advisors review.

INTERVIEW WORKSHOP

Interview Workshop aims to train students to:

- Strengthen knowledge of different interview settings;
- Enhance techniques to effectively tackle interview processes; and
- Improve confidence and first impression at job interviews.

Mock interviews are conducted in the workshop, and Career Advisors will provide immediate feedback.
