CIHE 7 Projects Granted by Research Grants Council (RGC)

A total of seven projects submitted by Caritas Institute of Higher Education (CIHE) has been funded under the Competitive Research Funding Schemes for the Local Self-financing Degree Sector 2020/21, in which "Creating an Automatic Football Commentary System with Image Recognition and Cantonese Voice Output", coordinated by the School of Computing and Information Sciences (School of CIS), has been awarded the largest amount of funding with HK\$6.8 million under the Institutional Development Scheme (IDS) Collaborative Research Grant.

The three-year project is collaborated among Prof SIU Wan-chi and Prof CHAN Hing-hung from School of CIS as well as Prof CHAN Sin-wai from the School of Humanities and Languages. This project aims to create an automatic football commentary system using imaging, pattern recognition and tracking technologies, image to text conversion, text to voice output functions, and machine learning techniques.

For IDS Research Infrastructure Grant, CIHE has received HK\$3.94 million for the establishment of Techno-Humanities Research Centre. Jointly operated by the School of Humanities and Languages and CIS, the centre aims to promote the use and development of technology in humanities research, provide technological facilities to colleagues to conduct research on techno-humanities, provide a platform for research collaboration on techno-humanities among tertiary institutions in Hong Kong, and create a network of techno-humanities scholars to advance academic study of this field.

The other five projects of CIHE have been granted a sum of HK\$2.95 million of funding under Faculty Development Scheme (FDS), and they are:

Thanks to the generous donation from Lions Clubs International District 303 Hong Kong & Macao, China, CIHE received HK\$1.39 million in support of the establishment of "CIHE Lions Club Diabetes Service Station", a diabetes centre located at the community health centre of CIHE to provide community health service to individuals with increased risk of developing diabetes or individuals with diabetes, and to the caregivers of diabetic patients.

Dr Kim MAK and Dr John LEUNG (District Governor) attended the signing ceremony held on 17 Oct 2020 and signed a Memorandum of Understanding to mark the collaboration. In the welcoming speech, Dr MAK said that the Station enjoys a close proximity to the Tiu Keng Leng MTR station, which will be an ideal location for carrying out diabetes screening and education work. He also revealed that CIHE will arrange over 1,000 health sciences students to provide support to the Station in the future.
